Both courses more recently received renovations - the Dunes Course in 1998 by Reese Jones, and the Shore Course was rebuilt in 2004 by Michael Strantz. As a result of a nine-year Facility Master Plan, guided from conception to completion by general manager Michael Bowhay, the remodel and expansion of its clubhouse and member facilities and services area was a priority for MPCC. Warner Group International of Santa Barbara, world renowned architect, created the fresh appearance.
